Tony Vitellone was born in Italy in August, 1890, and came to Whitefish about 20 years ago and has worked on the railway with the exception of about four years. He was accidentally killed March 1, 1933, near Blacktail station while working at snow removal. He was 42 years of age. His wife passed away about a year ago and he leaves his mother and two children and other relatives in Italy besides two brothers, Joe and Domineek in Whitefish and a brother in New York City.
