Joseph Imholt was born in Stillwater, Minn., June 17, 1867 and was a little over 68 years of age at the time of his death. In early manhood he took up the trade of a carpenter and followed that business throughout his life, building one of the first houses in Kalispell, and many of the first in Columbia Falls. He returned to North Hudson, Wisconsin, where he was united in marriage to Miss Sarah Munro, December 1, 1897. They returned to Columbia Falls.

To them a son, Bernard Imholt, was born in 1901. Mr. Imholt was a member of the town council for many years, and was elected as mayor in 1928. His wife preceded him in death, passing away in 1920. January 5, 1925, Mr. Imholt married Mrs. Evelyn Shrode of Kalispell, who with his son, two sisters and brother mourn his loss.
