Andrew Hendrik Iverson was born April 14, 1857, at Forde, Soddjord, Norway. He was one of 12 children of Iver and Rachel Aasen.

On May 27, 1890, he was married to Trine Rasmussen. To them six children were born. Two sons and one daughter passed away in early childhood.

In 1906, he immigrated to America and lived in Minnesota a short time. He came to Bigfork, Montana, in the fall of 1906, where he has since lived at his farm home. He passed away at his home January 5 following an illness of three weeks.

He is survived by his widow; one daughter, Anna H. Iverson; two sons Iver R. of Helena, and Carl R. of San Francisco; three brothers and two sisters in Norway; one brother in Minnesota, and several nieces and nephews.
