Berndt Olson was born at Malma, Sweden October 30, 1863 and died at Kalispell, Montana October 27, 1947 at the age of 83 years.

He grew up in Sweden and as a young man came to the United States. He was married to Miss Ophelia C. Lindelon in Howard, Kansas on October 10, 1891.

They came to the Flathead in 1910 to make their home on a farm at Foy's lake. They later moved to Demersville south of Kalispell and retired in 1940. Mrs. Olson passed away in Kalispell in 1941.

Mr. Olson is survived by two sons, Olen Olson of Whitefish and Albert A. Olson of Johnstown, Pennsylvania; three grandchildren, Mrs. John J. Hawkins, Georgia; Dr. Robert A. Olson of Williams Field, Arizona and Mrs. Benjamin Hachman of Carlisle, Penn.; and one great-grandson, born Sept. 28, 1947 at Carlisle, Penn.

He was with his brother-in-law, Oscar Scholl, and his nephew, Orland Scholl, on the trip.
