William F. Query, 79, died a his home, Rt. 2, Kalispell Tuesday. He was born Oct. 6. 1891 at Nordeway, Iowa, a son of James and Alvina Query. April 26, 1918, he entered the U.S. Army at Camp Dodge, Iowa and had served as a private in the Casualty Det., Co. M. 375th Infantry until receiving his honorable discharge April 11, 1919 at Camp Dodge.

March 21, 1918, he married Lydia Viola Dunn at Alliance, Neb. In 1920 the couple moved to Montana where they had homesteaded south of Chester until 1938 when they moved to the Flathead Valley. They then ranched near Kila for a time and had lived in Evergreen for 20 years prior to moving to their present home.

Mr. Query was a member of the Barracks of World War I and the Eagles Lodge. He is survived by his widow athome; one sister, Ruth Nepper of Omaha, Neb. and several other relatives.
