

Jacob Underwood Dies Saturday, Plan Services

WHITEFISH -- Jacob William Underwood, 88, Whitefish, died at Hot Springs Saturday. He was born April 14, 1883, at Rockport, Mo., a son of Alex and Mary Underwood. He had received his education in Missouri and in the early 1900s he moved to Bellefouche, S. D.

In 1913 he moved to Cut Bank where he homesteaded at Kevin. In 1919 he moved to Whitefish and was employed by the Great Northern Railway as a sheet metal worker until his retirement in 1954.

Dec. 10, 1904, he married Minnie Tolliver at Rockport, Mo. and was preceded in death by her March 25, 1962.

He is now survived by three sons, Jesse, Gerald and Bob, all of Whitefish; one grandson; four granddaughters; one brother, Lalis Underwood, Holdridge, Mo.; two sisters, Mrs. Ralph Bradley and Mrs. Otis Shafer, Rockport, and a number of other relatives.

W. H. Underwood Dies At Galen, Service Tuesday

Wesley H. Underwood, 71, died Thursday at Galen. He was born Nov. 26, 1899 at Woodstock, Minn., a son of John and Hattie Underwood.

In 1905, he moved with his family to Crystal Springs, N.D., where they homesteaded for a number of years. In 1939 he moved to Fairfield where he lived until moving to Somers in 1949.

He had continued to live at Somers until entering the Galen hospital five years ago. He was of the Lutheran Faith. Aug. 17, 1945, he married Betty Jean Decker at Great Falls and was preceded in death by her May 14, 1964. He was also preceded in death by his parents and one brother and is now survived by one sister, Mrs. Blanche Leopold, Jamestown, N.D.
