MISSOULA — Elaine Zadra, 58, of Missoula, died here Tuesday morning, following an illness.

She was born Oct. 23, 1918 in Glendive and attended schools there. After high school she moved to Missoula and worked for F.A. Buttrey.

She married James Zadra in Missoula Sept. 17, 1938 and they moved to Plains. The couple later moved to Kalispell, where they were involved in the Zadra Logging Co. They returned to Missoula in 1969. Mr. Zadra died in 1971.
