He was born Sept. 19, 1913, in Rapid City, S.D., a son of Willard and Alma Behrens Underwood.

He was a wildlife enthusiast and avid photographer until the age of 36 when he suffered a bout of polio and was confined to a wheelchair.

In 1958 he was married to Flora Edwards in Torrington, Wyo.

In 1973, they moved to Polson, where they have since resided. He was baptised as a Jehovah's Witness in 1976.

He is survived by his wife, Flora, of Polson; a son, Chan, Jackson, Wyo.; a daughter, Susan Andrew, Torrington, Wyo.; two step-daughters, Carolyn Attig, Rochester, Wash., and Connie Kackley, Arlington, Texas; two sisters, Eleanor Elliot and Doris Reynolds, both of Rapid City; 13 grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.
