

## Leo Unruh

Leo Unruh passed away on Dec. 8, 2002, at St. Patrick's Hospital in Missoula.

He was born to Jacob and Anna Unruh in Richey on Sept. 8, 1915.

He came to Pablo from Richey in 1937. He married Shirley Anders on Sept. 11, 1940 in Pablo.

Leo was a veteran. He spent 22 months overseas and was at Normandy Beach.
